Hall of Famers Alcott, Bradley, Carner, King, Sheehan Confirmed for the Legends Tour Open Championship at Innisbrook in November

INNISBROOK, FL, October 26, 2009 – LPGA and World Golf Hall of Famers Amy Alcott, Pat Bradley, JoAnne Carner, Betsy King and Patty Sheehan have committed to compete in the Legends Tour Open Championship to be played November 20-22, 2009. In addition to the five Hall of Famers, 34 other LPGA Superstars such as Rosie Jones, Nancy Scranton and Jan Stephenson are confirmed to tee it up on Innisbrook Resort and Golf Club's Island Course to compete for a \$300,000 purse in The Legends Tour's first major.
